## JANUARY 2023

- Jan 3 School re-opens
- Jan 4 First day of classes Scheduled Orientation session for students & instructors
- Jan 9-15 **NVIT** - 75% Tuition refund for courses dropped when course add do not result in equivalent credits
- Jan 16-22 **NVIT** – 50% Tuition refund for courses dropped when course add do not result in equivalent credits
- Jan 22 **NVIT** Last day to add or drop classes
- Jan 20 **UVIC** Last day for 100% reduction of second term fees for standard courses  
50% of tuition fees will be assessed for courses dropped after this date.
- Jan 25 **UVIC** Last day for adding courses that begin in the second term
