- Post Secondary eligibility is not a requirement! This is a professional career training opportunity.

PORTFOLIOS MUST INCLUDE:

1. Letter of intent – Please indicate why you want to take the program and your level of commitment to the arts.
2. Two letters of support reference from organizations or individuals qualified to assess your current works
3. Examples of works will be accepted in one of the following formats:
 - I. 15 slides/ prints of current works clearly labeled.
 - II. 5 pages of current written or previous work published.
 - III. Demo reels of your work – utube, vimeo link or USB
 - IV. For Oral and Performance installations USB submissions may be submitted.All work must be clearly labeled with explanations.
