Bachelor of Fine Arts in Visual Arts

Students who have completed ART 100E, ART 101E and ART 150E enter directly into 2nd year

Elective credit is given for additional ART 100 - level courses

ART211E and/or ART221E count as second year core courses

CW credits can be used as non-art electives

Bachelor of Arts in Writing & Bachelor of Fine Arts in Writing

Students who have completed CW 101E and CW102E with grades of B or better, enter directly into 2nd year

Elective credit is given for additional courses from En'owkin

- Apply UVic by January 31
- Submit transcripts to Admissions
- Include transcripts for English credits as they can be used towards the degree
- Submit portfolio to Visual Arts by January 31
